

GOURMET SERIES GRILL

TROUBLE SHOOTING GUIDE

Problem	Possible Cause	Possible Solution
Burner will not light with igniter	Igniter/electrode covered with grease or residue	Clean igniter electrode
	Igniter/electrode too far from burner	Adjust electrode until proper spark appears
	Igniter/electrode wire loose or disconnected	Reconnect wire between igniter & electrode
	Wire is shorted causing spark from wire before electrode	Call Magma
	No spark being generated	Call Magma
Burner will not light even with match	No gas flow	Check fuel level, refill cylinder or replace canister
	Obstructed gas flow/debris or spider webs in burner tube	Clean valve orifice and burner check all lines
Flare-up	Excessive cooking temperature	Operate only on low when lid is closed
		Reduce flame level
		Leave lid open
		Use water spray to cool
	Grease and/residue build-up	Clean components
	Excessive fat in meats	Trim fat from cuts of meat before grilling
	Excessive oils in marinades	Use non-oil based marinades
Yellow sooty flame	Obstruction of gas flow/debris or spider webs in burner tube	Check and clean valve orifice and burner
Blow-out	Flame too low	Increase flame
	Wind directly on burner	Block wind when opening lid
	Obstructed gas flow	Clean burner or valve orifice
