
## RV ENTRANCE DOOR Interior Windor Frame

## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Glass window is held in position by frames only. Exercise caution during dismantling process. Avoid sharp edges on glass.

## To remove old frame:

- 1. Remove the 12 screws on the interior frame and gently pull frame back, being careful not to let the glass fall out.
- 2. Before removing the exterior frame, use a razor knife to cut a slit in any existing silicone or putty, being careful not to cut or puncture the exterior skin of the door.
- 3. Gently remove exterior frame. Use caution if glass is still in place.
- 4. After both frames have been removed, clean the door surface and the glass surface of all sealants and adhesives.

## To install new frame:

- 1. Apply a layer of putty or butyl tape around the outer perimeter of exterior frame on the side that will be flush against door. (Exterior frame does not have screw holes.)
- 2. Apply a light bead of silicone sealant around the interior perimeter of the exterior frame where glass sits on frame and mount glass to frame.
- 3. Carefully mount exterior frame to door. Position interior frame so that screw holes are aligned. (Silicone sealant may be applied to interior perimeter of interior frame prior to mounting.)
- 4. Insert screws and tighten, being careful not to over-tighten.
- 5. Carefully trim away excess putty and/or silicone sealant.

It is strongly recommended that both interior and exterior frames be replaced at the same time.
